At all in person voting options, Election Officers will be wearing a facial covering. We ask that voters maintain social distancing and have their ID ready. Voters will have hand sanitizer available as they are checked in as usual, offered a pen to keep, and their ballot. Tables are available (sanitized regularly) for voters to mark their ballot, once the ballot is completed the voter will be directed to the appropriate scanner into which the voter will insert his or her ballot. Look for the waving flag on the screen, YOUR BALLOT HAS BEEN PROCESSED.

Voters logging on will be inputting information for verification purposes. Voters calling will be asked information for verification purposes. Voters will be mailed a BALLOT PACKET. The packet will be in a large white envelope from the County Clerk's office addressed to each voter.

STEP 1 Mark your ballot, only 1 choice per race unless the ballot indicates you can choose more than 1. If you make a MISTAKE, please CIRCLE your correct choice.

STEP 2 Place the voted ballot inside the Inner Envelope. SIGN THE FLAP

(IF you need help and someone assists you, they must complete and sign the VOTER ASSISTANCE FORM that is on the flap of the Inner Envelope. If the voter CANNOT sign the envelope and uses an X two witnesses are required to sign.) DO NOT DETACH THE FLAP

STEP 3 Place the Inner Envelope, with the voted ballot inside and the flap signed, inside the Outer Envelope. You MUST SIGN the outer envelope. (If the voter CANNOT sign the envelope and uses an X two witnesses are required to sign.)

STEP 4 You may return the ballot packet by MAIL (must be postmarked by NOVEMBER 3 and received by NOVEMBER 6) or you may use the drop box located at the south side of the Courthouse 101 South 5<sup>th</sup> St. Between 8am and 4:30p Monday-Friday. (Drop box is under video surveillance) \*REMEMBER TO SIGN & SEAL BOTH ENVELOPES\*
