ORDINANCE NO. 07-0619-B

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CALLOWAY COUNTY CEMETERY BOARD.

WHEREAS, KRS 67.680, authorizes local governments to enact ordinances establishing cemetery boards in order to secure finances for the restoration and maintenance of non profit cemeteries which do not receive perpetual funds and, whereas the Calloway County Fiscal Court is desirous of establishing such a county cemetery board in order to properly restore and maintain non profit cemetery within the boundaries of Calloway County, the following ordinances is hereby adopted:

**SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF CALLOWAY COUNTY;**

**A. Establishment of the Cemetery Board**

A board is hereby established in Calloway County, hereinafter to be known as the Calloway County Cemetery Board. The Calloway County Cemetery Boards express purpose for existence is to restore and maintain non profit cemeteries located within the boundaries of Calloway County that do not receive perpetual care funds.

**B. Board Members, Qualifications, Meeting Times**

1. The Calloway County Cemetery Board shall consist of five voluntary members with no more than three members representing the same political party.
2. The Calloway County Cemetery Board members shall be appointed by the Calloway County Judge Executive with approval of the fiscal court.
3. The members of the Calloway County Board shall have lived in Calloway County for at least one year prior to their appointment and members shall have demonstrated an interest in cemetery preservation and genealogy and or local history.
4. The Calloway County Cemetery Board shall meet at least three times annually and the public shall be given notice of the date, time and place of said meetings. All meetings of the Calloway County Cemetery Board shall be open to the public and subject to Kentucky's Open Meetings Law.
5. The terms of the board members shall be for four years.

### C. Cemetery Board Chairman

1. The Calloway County Cemetery Board shall choose a chairman from among the five members. This chairman shall be responsible for insuring that appropriate minutes are taken at each cemetery board meeting. These minutes shall be kept and preserved by the Chairman for review by the Calloway County Fiscal Court.
2. Decisions made by the Calloway County Cemetery Board shall be accomplished by a majority vote of board members present at each meeting.
3. Three board members are necessary to constitute a Quorum in order to conduct Calloway County Cemetery Board meetings.


### SECTION II. VALIDITY




